Miles Community College awards credit toward graduation for successful performance in certain subject examinations of the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) conducted by the College Entrance Examination Board. All available tests are administered via computer on campus. The cost is \$95 for each test (\$80 to CLEP, plus a \$15 MCC administrative fee).

The College will accept up to a maximum of 30 semester credits for satisfactory scores on the subject examinations. CLEP courses will be recorded as "P" grades on official transcripts. Scores below the passing level will not be entered on transcripts.
