Miles Community College Pioneer Express Courses (eLearning only) - Fall 2025

Classes begin August 28, 2025 - Registration deadline August 20, 2025

Important things to know about Pioneer Express and Free 2 Explore at Miles Community College:

- Students enrolling with MCC as a dual enrollment student for the first time must submit the Pioneer Express/Dual Enrollment Application Form (online or on paper) AND the Pioneer Express Registration Form (paper form only due to signature requirements). If students have submitted a Pioneer Express Application in a previous term, only the Pioneer Express Registration Form is needed. The Registration Form, with signatures, is required every term a high school student takes classes.
- A majority of online courses fill very early many in mid-summer, well before the registration deadline. It is suggested that students register for fall classes before the end of the prior school year; students should have alternate classes in mind if needed. High School students will not be waitlisted for classes unless there are exceptional circumstances.
- Many courses have pre-requisite requirements, which must be demonstrated through a minimum high school GPA, ACT scores, or placement test. **Students must submit an unoffical high school transcript and/or ACT scores with their application.** Course pre-requisites are listed next to the course. Students may also take a math or writing placement via the MCC Learning Center.
- Free 2 Explore waiver applies to first two classes **TOTAL**, not two per term. Tuition is still waived after Free 2 Explore eligibility is expended, and students pay only campus mandatory and course fees for additional Pioneer Express courses. This is still a savings of over 50% off the regular full-price course cost.
- Whether under Free 2 Explore or Pioneer Express, students are responsible for the cost of course fees and textbooks (including eTextbooks/embedded textbook fees). Please note that depending on the subject, this can be an significant expense. A textbook list, with costs, is available on the MCC Bookstore website at https://store.milescc.edu/book-lists
- Shipping for textbooks and materials may take several business days, or longer if items are backordered during late registration periods or for high demand classes. It is recommended to order textbooks BEFORE the term begins so that students have all materials ready on the first day of class.
- In-Person, Online, video conferencing/remote-real time, or Hyflex course delivery available. Please see the website for distance delivery mode/section letter descriptions.
- 'L' designator on section = online course; 'H' designator on section = Hyflex course; 'V' designator on section = Video course; no letter designation = in-person; 'V' courses with times listed require real-time attence via Zoom. 'H' courses can be completed asychronously but students may join via Zoom if their schedule allows.
- This schedule is subject to change. Courses must have sufficient enrollment to run. High School students will not be waitlisted unless there are exceptional circumstances.
