

Download & Install Read & Write Gold for Mac

1. Click the **Read & Write Gold for MACs (under the Downloads)** link next to Mac OS X.

Once the file has finished downloading you will need to adjust the security settings on your Computer to in order to install. Choose the instructions appropriate for your Mac's OS:

Mac OS 10.11 (and older versions) Instructions

Adjust security setting:

- a) Click the **Apple icon** on the top menu bar.
- b) Select **System Preferences > Security & Privacy.**



- c) Click the **lock icon** in left corner.



- d) Enter your computer's password when prompted.
- e) Select **Anywhere** located under *Allow apps downloaded from:*
- f) Click **Allow from Anywhere** button when prompted.


Install and Activate (for all Mac OS versions):

- 1) Go to the Downloads folder on your computer (or wherever you downloaded the installer file) and click **ReadWriteTakeHome.dmg** to open.

2) Please copy the Read&Write Gold folder to /users/shared folder, Go to "/users/shared"

Click **Read&Write Gold.app** .


3) Click the **Open** button when prompted.



4) *The Read&Write Gold toolbar will open and be displayed on your screen.*



5) Click the **Allow** button when asked to accept incoming network connections.



You are ready to use R&WG.

You may be asked to download an RWG extension or plug-in for your browsers, after installing R&WG. Follow the prompts to install.

To reset your computer's Security setting, OS 10 versions 11 and older users should return to the Adjust security section above and repeat steps until step i.e., where you can change the setting from Any back to App Store and identified developers. Click the lock icon to save setting.

MacOS Sierra users, go to the Return to original security setting section below.

MacOS Sierra (10.12.) Instructions

Adjust security setting:


1. Open **Finder** and go to **Applications> Utilities**.
- 2.

In the **Utilities** folder, locate and open **Terminal**.



3. In **Terminal**, type (or copy then paste) the command below as shown below.

```
sudo spctl --master-disable
```



4. Enter your **computer's password**.

Go to the [Install and Activate \(for all versions\) instructions](#) above to complete installation and activation.


After you have completed installation you can reset the security settings by following steps 1 and 2 above, then continue below:

[Return to original security setting](#)

Type (or copy/paste) the following line in the Terminal:

```
sudo spctl --master-enable
```

4. Enter your computer's password as before.
