

# HIGH SCHOOL PATHWAY FOR REGISTERED NURSES

## HIGH SCHOOL TRACK

(MUST BE A MINIMUM OF 16 YEARS OF AGE TO BEGIN DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES)

### SOPHOMORE

Semester 1: Express interest in health care and meet with a counselor regarding enrollment at MCC.

Semester 2: Complete Allied Health Medical Support 129.

April/May: Ask about the high school pathway/early college track for students interested in nursing.

Summer (1): \*Supplemental courses may be taken during this time.

### JUNIOR

Semester 1 and/or 2: Complete Chemistry 121/122 & Writing 101.

April/May: Ask about the Nursing Student Success Pathway, designated for high school students. Learn more at: [bit.ly/NursingStudentSuccessPathway](http://bit.ly/NursingStudentSuccessPathway).

Summer (2): \*Supplemental courses may be taken during this time.

### SENIOR

Semester 1 and/or 2: Complete Math 140 & Human Biology 201/202.

April/May: Complete Kaplan Entrance Exam testing & apply to the MCC Nursing Program (if not already completed). Application deadline is June 1.

Summer (3): \*Supplemental courses may be taken during this time.

Courses designated with a double asterisk (\*\*) are not required to follow the standard sequence and may be completed earlier than indicated in the nursing program scope and sequence.
