This two-year (60(61) credit) emphasis is designed for students transferring to a four-year college or university to complete a degree in Social Work and Human & Social Services. - Obtain a comprehensive general education core background for transfer to a four-year program.
- Have completed the first-two years toward obtaining a bachelor's degree related to human and social services.
