On-campus housing in Pioneer Hall is available for these select SOAR sessions:

Driving Directions to Miles Community College

From I-94:

- Take Exit 138.
- Travel north along Haynes Ave. (Highway 59)
- Turn left onto Dickinson (by the new First Interstate Bank)
- Follow Dickinson until you reach the Miles Community College east parking lot, labeled parking area 1
- Lucas Hall is the main building on the Miles Community College campus; parking in parking area 1 and entering through Door C will take you directly to Student Services.

From downtown Miles City:

- Travel east along Main Street.
- Turn right onto Sewell Ave. (after the MCC Workforce Readiness Center).
- Follow Sewell Ave. until you reach the Miles Community College west parking lot, labeled parking area 3.
- Lucas Hall is the main building on the Miles Community College campus; entering through Door D will take you directly to Student Services.
