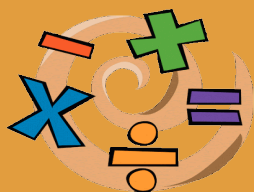




Math Success

Achievement Through Competent Math



To improve their math proficiency, students who struggle with math need intensive, systematic, and explicit instruction in addition to their regular classroom in the following components:

- Integers and all processes
- Equations and expressions
- Geometric skills
- Coordinate plan, surface area and area/volume of shapes
- Statistics and probability in a data set.

The activities in this curriculum are intended to supplement the regular math program and to provide the additional practice children need to develop basic math strategies.
